GALA IS ALIVE IN MICHIGAN

TREASURER REPORT

Well, I have some good news and some bad news.

First, the good news. GALA is looking good financially—we have nearly \$25,000 in the bank as of the end of February. The organization has come out of 2016 about \$5,000 in the black, thanks to generous donations of money and silent auction items. Thank you all for your generosity!

Now for the bad news. So far this year, membership is significantly down from previous years. Last year over the course of the full year, we had 80 memberships (family, individual, or limited income). So far this year, three months into the year, we are only at 24 memberships. Please review your finances and decide if you can support GALA by purchasing a membership at any level. We are also looking into ways to recognize memberships more effectively than we have in the past—perhaps a discount on the

Here in Michigan, we have been wondering what we could do to make a difference in LGBT issues in our state. Erin Cavanaugh stepped out in faith and contacted the Michigan Mission Center President and we met with him to determine ways that we could be by Lisa Meyer included throughout the mission center. Dan Nowiski (Michigan Mission Center President) invited GALA to present during the Sunday morning class time at Mission Center Conference, which was hugely successful! Erin Cavanaugh presented on GALA and WCN and the processes of becoming welcoming to LGBT persons in congregations and in the mission center.

> In addition, GALA had an informational table/display at the Mission Center conference as well. As part of this display, several events were scheduled for the first half of 2017. So far, Erin and I have planned and carried out a full-day Welcoming Workshop that we plan to replicate across Michigan. At the initial workshop, we had 8 participants from 2 congregations—not too bad considering that Michigan had some nasty weather that weekend. We have another one scheduled for April 8 in the northern half of Michigan. We have already had several requests to offer the workshop in other

congregations around the state. We have also held a movie/panel afternoon at another congregation in Michigan, which had around 10 participants. From these events held so far, we have at least 3 congregations seriously considering/starting the Welcoming process to become officially Welcoming congregations. One of these congregations invited Erin and myself to speak on a Sunday morning to share our experiences and have already invited us back to speak again. GALA is alive and well in Michigan!

PRAYER FOR PEACE

Regardless of political stance, it is important for us to draw together in prayer for peace in our world. This is especially important in 2017, since one has only to turn on the television or read the newspaper to see the many places struggling with a lack of peace..

Wallace B. Smith, church president from 1978–1996, presented instructions to the 1984 World Conference regarding building the Temple in Independence, Missouri. Included in this counsel are words that set the tone for the building: "The Temple shall be dedicated to the pursuit of peace. It shall be for reconciliation and healing of the spirit" (Doctrine and Covenants 156:5a). The Daily Prayer for Peace started December 3, 1993, on the first day of the Peace Colloquy at the Temple.

Each day a prayer is offered for a specific country based on the World Council of Churches' ecumenical prayer cycle.
